## Teenie Beanie Runner Bean

The first true mini-podded runner bean available to the amateur gardener.

Thompson & Morgan already offers 14 runner bean varieties, all of which are over 30cm (12in) in length. **New for 2007** Thompson & Morgan has discovered the unique **Teenie Beanie** which produces pods no longer than 15cm (6in) on traditional tall climbing plants.

**Runner Bean Teenie Beanie** prolifically produces red flowers, followed by bunches of short pods up to 15cm (6in) long by 20mm ( $\frac{3}{4}$ in) wide, which are stringless when picked at this size. A bumper crop of succulent, delicious baby pods can be picked continuously throughout the summer.

In our trials against other mini-runner beans available from supermarkets, we found these other varieties were not as stringless as **Teenie Beanie** and the flavour of **Teenie Beanie** was far superior. The stringless baby pods of **Teenie Beanie** are also easy for kitchen preparation.

**Teenie Beanie** is best sown from mid April to early June and will be ready to harvest during the summer going into autumn. The baby pods also make a fun crop for children to grow and eat.
