Chartwell produces excellent quality hearts which have good downy mildew resistance. They also have excellent resistance to bolting during hot summer conditions, which is a real benefit as many other lettuce varieties of this type will quickly bolt if the summers are very hot.

Chartwell can be used as a cut and come again, a baby salad leaf or as a mature hearted lettuce. We have found that cut heads can keep for up to two weeks when placed in the bottom of a refrigerator. This variety can be used for spring and summer sowings and will be ready to harvest from June to October.
